TAKATA AIRBAGS

Takata Components, a supplier manufacturer, is one of the largest suppliers of airbags. It is alleged that people have been hurt from Takata's airbag manufacturing and quality control system, improper labeling of airbag systems and in other cases, death. Since 2013, the U.S. Department of Justice has announced several recalls, which is an intentional failure and lack of adequate training to its workforce to make certain key airbag components and to adequately follow these instructions.

TAKATA LAWSUITS

The Japanese corporation Takata facing a growing number of lawsuits brought by those airbags that they were able to fit. The lawsuits are for lost earnings, lost sales, lost profits, lost income, or earnings in the public, and others.

85 There are currently 85 Takata airbag lawsuits pending.
