Consequences of anchor equipment loss/damage

Direct consequences:

- Replacement and recovery cost
- Off-hire and service delays

Indirect consequences:

- Grounding, collision, dragging:
 - Damage to ship/other ship, subsea equipment, pipelines, cables etc.
- Pollution

The most serious and high impact cases occur when a ship's anchor is dragging or loses the anchor under bad weather conditions!
