
BETTER BUSINESS: HIPAA — Privacy and Security Basics

Nowadays, it's so easy to have PHI on an online database, but it also invites the opportunities for an invasion of privacy. The solution is not revert back to paper, but rather you should be educated on techniques for ensuring privacy is protected. This course is designed to do exactly that.

You will learn about the basics surrounding the HIPAA, including: what information is considered to fall under PHI; who is responsible for protecting PHI and Personal Health Records (PHR) under the HIPAA; and the significant financial consequences for violating the HIPAA. If you didn't have your fill of acronyms, we will also dicsuss basic IT measures that can be taken to reduce the risk of violating privacy. There is a lot that you, personally, can do to protect everyone's PHI. This course will identify behaviors and methods that make it easier for information to be hacked or leaked, such as Bluetooth and public networks. In addition, we will supply you with methods to improve security on mobile devices and within the workplace.
