Not considering insulation, ventilation, wiring and moisture control before installing the drywall. If you want to keep your home damage-free, make sure to take these factors into account.

Thinking that all drywall is the same. There are many different types, each offering distinctive features such as moisture and mold resistance

Using excessively long drywall screws. Long screws don't necessarily improve the structural integrity of your home or the drywall's connection to the framing. In fact, these screws can increase the potential for damage to plumbing and wiring within the walls.
