Eye Wash Stations & Showers To Enable You To Meet...

GENERAL SAFETY REGULATIONS - GNR.1031 OF 30 MAY 1986

Regulation 3.8:

When an “employee is exposed or can be exposed to a potential hazard of injury to the eye through contact with a biological or chemical substance”, the employee should “make sure that there is an eyewash fountain” or similar facilities in the workplace.

Regulation 3.9:

“Where an employee at a workplace is exposed or can be exposed to a potential hazard of injury to or absorption through the skin as a result of sudden contact with a contact with a large amount of toxic, corrosive, high risk or similar hazardous substance”, the employee “must make sure that there is a fast-reacting deluge-shower with clean water or a similar facility” in the workplace.
