


Flagger Safety on Construction Sites Infographic



What Should Flaggers Avoid?

Flaggers must avoid dangerous behavior. Here are some flagging DON'TS:

- Don't stand where you can be crushed.
- Don't stand in the shade over the crest of a hill or around a sharp curve.
- Don't leave your position until properly relieved.
- Don't stand near equipment.
- Don't stand in a group.
- Don't make unrelated conversation.
- Don't read or daydream on duty.
- Don't listen to music or use ear phones.
- Don't turn your back to the traffic.
