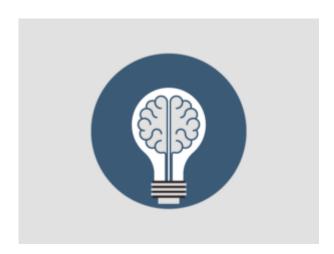
FUNDAMENTAL 55: Cannabis Workplace Safety for Employers
