State Laws may not specifically require employers to keep data specifically on minors, although general recordkeeping requirements on the federal level may

Keep records for preceding 12 months for one year from the date of the minors latest work period. Special requirements exist for minors under age 16 employed in agriculture.

Work Permit or Age Certificate Required

Yes. Part-time employment certificate permits minors 14 or 15 to work during vacations, and work-training certificate permits minors 14 or 15 to work during school hours.
