SEVEN STEPS FOR LOCKOUT/TAGOUT:

- Prepare for shutdown
- Shutdown the machines or equipment
- 3 Disconnect the energy-isolating devices
- Apply the lockout or tagout devices
- Render all stored and residual energy safe
- Verify the isolation and deenergization of the machine or equipment prior to starting work
 - Reactivate following specific procedures
