• Status of Offense. The status of the offense is listed only if state labor statutes expressly define the nature of the offense.

Status of Offense

Administrative penalty. (Note: A repeated violation is a Class B misdemeanor.)

Fines

\$500 maximum per violation

Imprisonment

State law does not provide a penalty. Criminal action, however, may be taken against an employer that violates the law 3 times within 3 years.
