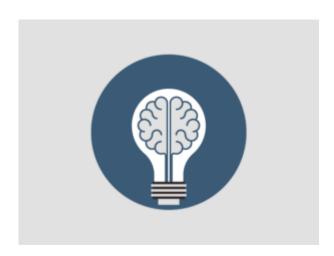
PPE — Personal Protective Equipment — Construction

Course Description

- Workers are confident in the correct use, care, limitations and assigned maintenance of the PPE.
