DID YOU KNOW...

 <p>The lap belt and shoulder belt are secured across your pelvis and rib cage – because these are the strongest areas of your body that are able to withstand crash forces.</p>	 <p>Seat belt webbing is made of a flexible material. It will stretch a little so your stop isn't so sudden.</p>	 <p>Seat belts can extend and retract. In a crash, the belt will tighten to hold you in place.</p>
