Invented in 1958, the 3-point seatbelt remains the most successful contribution to safety in the history of motoring.



DID YOU KNOW...



The lap belt and shoulder belt are secured across your pelvis and rib cage – because these are the strongest areas of your body that are able to withstand crash forces.



Seat belt webbing is made of a flexible material. It **will** stretch a little so your stop isn't so sudden.



Seat belts **can** extend and retract. In a crash, the belt **will** tighten to hold you in place.
