First and foremost, every employer should have an official written policy on the use of cell phones and all electronic devices. Even those companies who do not want employees using cell phones and/or electronic devices, they should include that very prohibition in their employee handbook and/or policy manual in order to avoid any confusion as to your company's position.

While various states and local municipalities have either implemented or proposed similar legislation, employers in every geographic area should err on the side of caution, and either strictly prohibits the use of cell phones for business purposes while operating a motor vehicle, or if necessary, mandate the use of a hands-free device. Not only will this limit any potential liability that might arise from the employee's use of a cell phone, it also helps to protect employees who may inadvertently enter a jurisdiction with cell phone laws.
